### 3. Hazards identification

#### Additional information

Prolonged or repeated exposure through inhalation of vapours may damage the central nervous system. The product releases vapours which may cause lethargy and dizziness. At high concentrations, the vapours may cause headache and intoxication.

### 4. First aid measures

#### Inhalation

#### Ingestion

Rinse mouth thoroughly and then drink plenty of water. Seek medical advice if symptoms persist.

#### Skin

Remove contaminated clothes. Wash skin with water and soap. Seek medical advice if symptoms persist.

#### Eyes

Rinse immediately with water (preferably using eye wash) for at least 5 minutes. Open eyes wide. Remove any contact lenses. Seek medical advice if irritation persists.

### 5. Fire-fighting measures

### 8. Exposure controls/ personal protection

#### Precautions for use

Work must be done with effective process ventilation (e.g. local extractor fan). There should be access to running water and eye wash. Wash hands before breaks and toilet visits and after work.
